## ARTICLE VI **EXECUTIVE BOARD**

## **Section 3. Area Board Members**

There shall be ten Area Board Members, five elected from Laredo ISD and five elected from United ISD. Within each district, three Area Board Members shall be Active-Professional Board members and two shall be Active-ESP Board members. The three Active-Professional Board members from each district shall be one from a high school, one from a middle school, one from an elementary school; and the eligible voters for electing each position shall be all Active-Professional members in the respective districts. The two ESP Area Board Members from each district shall be elected by the Active-ESP members in the district, except that if 40% or more of the Active-ESP member in a district come from a single department or unit transportation, food service, custodial. buildina secretarial/clerical, security, para-professional, etc.), then the ESP members of that that department or unit shall elect one of the ESP Area Board Members and the other shall be elected by the remaining ESP membership.

## **Section 4. Duties**

## The Executive Board shall:

- A. B. C. be responsible to the membership in all matters;
- carry out the policies of the Association; attend to the business of the Association between meetings of the
- members; serve as liaison to committees as assigned by the President; have care of any real property owned by the Association; D.
- approve all members of committees/task forces; F.
- G. receive all reports submitted by or requested from committees;
- Н. set election dates and member meeting dates;
- I. review January 15 membership numbers each year and make any necessary changes in Area Board Members based on Section 3 of this Article
- approve or reject contracts presented by the President;

- approve or reject contracts presented by the President; recommend an annual budget for adoption at the April or May membership meeting; annually review the Association bylaws and present any proposed amendments to an all-member meeting for approval; establish Association Policy and share it with the members; any Association Policy can be changed by the members voting at a meeting of the membership.
